SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT
FALL SEMESTER 2023

To the Applicant:

Vietnam Veterans of America (VVA) and Associates (AVVA) of Chapter 991 of Palestine are conducting a scholarship program that will provide a scholarship grant of up to \$1,000 for the fall semester for an applicant who is a graduating high school student, including home-schoolers, from our service area. The criteria for award of the scholarship are listed below.

- A Vietnam Veteran or Vietnam-era Veteran must be within the family. The Vietnam Veteran must have served in the Vietnam War Zone on active military duty other than for training between February 28, 1961, and May 7, 1975; or, Vietnam-era Veterans must have served on active duty at any location other than for training between August 5, 1964, and May, 1975.
- The Vietnam War or Vietnam-era Veteran must currently reside in one of the following counties: Anderson, Cherokee, Freestone, Henderson, Houston, Leon, or Limestone. Or, if the Veteran is deceased, the Veteran lived in one of these Counties while alive.
- The scholarship is for an Applicant who will be enrolling in a four-year college or university, a junior or community college, or technical trade school with intent to pursue a bachelor degree, associate degree, or certificate of completion.
- The Veteran's DD-214 or other documentary evidence from the U.S military is required.
- A personal letter discussing the reasons for your request, school activities, financial needs, career ambition on completion of your degree, and any pertinent points you think are applicable.
- Other items as listed on the Application Form.
